

1 3. Petitioner personally appeared at the Order to Show Cause hearings and Further Trial
2 Readiness Conference on January 7, 2020 with counsel from CKB Vienna, L.L.P, Ariel D. Carter.
3 Respondent also personally appeared at the hearing. Respondent was escorted out of the court mid-
4 hearing. The matter was heard by the Honorable Judge Lawrence P. Riff and orders were made
5 regarding the Orders to Show Cause and for trial.

6 4. Under California Rules of Court Rule 3.1312 and California Rules of Court Rule 5.125, a
7 proposed Findings and Order after Hearing was forwarded to Respondent for her approval on January
8 10, 2020. Attached as **Exhibit A**, incorporated herein by reference is a true and correct copy of the
9 correspondence sent to Respondent dated January 10, 2020 which was sent by U.S. Mail.

10 5. Of note, is the fact that Respondent was escorted out of the hearing prior to the conclusion of
11 the hearing. Since she was present initially, I served her the proposed findings and order after
12 hearing.

13 6. I received an email from Respondent on January 15, 2020 wherein, amongst other things, she
14 indicated, "I am contacting you regarding the Findings and Order After hearing and Notice of Trial. I
15 am contacting you to confirm that I am in receipt. I will respond to you within the time requested."
16 Attached as **Exhibit B** and incorporated herein by reference is a true and correct copy of the email
17 thread of January 15, 2020, between Respondent and I.

18 7. On January 21, 2020, I received another email from Respondent with an attached Objection to
19 the Findings and Order After Hearing and Notice of Trial. Attached as **Exhibit C** and incorporated
20 herein by reference is a true and correct copy of the email and attachment from January 21, 2020
21 from Respondent. Respondent has not identified any discrepancies with the formal order. She simply
22 indicated that she did not agree with the court's orders. This is not a basis for objection to the
23 proposed findings and order after hearing.

24 8. Since the notice of trial does not need to be approved by Respondent, in an abundance of
25 caution, I am submitting a separate notice of trial. However, the proposed Findings and Order After
26 Hearing accurately details the findings and orders of the court made on January 7, 2020. Therefore, I
